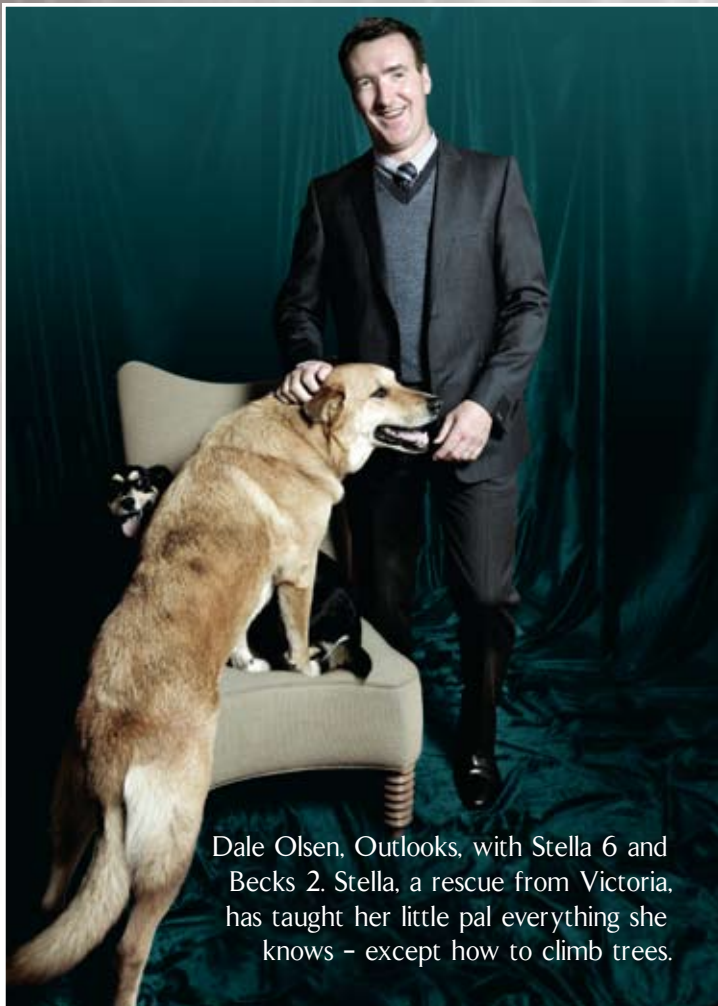


Iain Russell, Outlooks, with Henry 6 and Gino 2.
